Scholarship/Toolship Parameters

Committee: Members of the Eastham Chamber of Commerce Philanthropic/Scholarship Committee

Award: \$1,000 Scholarship

Eligibility for Eastham Chamber of Commerce Scholarship:

1. Resident of Eastham
2. Accepted by or currently enrolled in a 2 or 4 year college or vocational-technical school or college
3. May be a prior, one-time recipient of either the Eastham Chamber of Commerce Scholarship or the Betty Fleming Memorial Nursing Scholarship
4. Graduating high school senior or current full time college student with a minimum overall 2.5 GPA

Eligibility for Betty Fleming Memorial Nursing Scholarship:

1. Resident of Eastham
2. Accepted by or currently enrolled in a 2 or 4 college nursing program of studies
3. May be a prior, one-time recipient of either the Eastham Chamber of Commerce Scholarship or the Betty Fleming Memorial Nursing Scholarship
4. Graduating high school senior or current full time college student with a minimum overall 2.5 GPA

Eligibility for Eastham Chamber of Commerce Trades Toolship:

1. Resident of Eastham
2. Currently employed or to be employed upon graduation as an apprentice to a private contractor or in food service industry to learn technical skills via on-the-job training
3. Must provide letter confirming apprenticeship from employer
4. Must provide letter explaining what kind of supplies, tools or equipment you would purchase
5. Graduate of High School or Technical High School with a minimum overall 2.5 GPA

Application: Completed application and attachments must be received by the Eastham Chamber of Commerce, P.O. Box 1329, Eastham, MA 02642 not later than April 1.

Payment: Directly to the winners with a minimum overall 2.5 GPA and completion of the semester following the notice of this award, and proof of continued enrollment or completion of the degree program. Toolship will be paid out as a reimbursement for receipts submitted to the Eastham Chamber of Commerce for tools or equipment directly related to the apprenticeship.
